**FROM THE SOUTH**

1. From I-25 North, take exit 135 Academy Blvd
2. North on Academy 5.8 miles to East Platte Ave
3. Right on E. Platte 3.7 miles to Hwy 94 (direction Shriever AFB)
4. Right on Hwy 94 7.5 miles to Curtis Road (2nd light on Hwy 94)
5. Left on Curtis Road 1.9 miles to mailbox 2115 and Zoiboyz Ranch on right—it is the house surrounded by white fence on the hill. (Ignore the small house in front near Curtis Road. You've gone too far north on Curtis if you come to Falcon Hwy and a blinking red traffic signal.)

### How to use Entry Forms

1. Complete a separate entry form for each dog.
2. Enter your dog's AKC number (PAL/ILP and Canine Partners numbers) - if you do not have a number, please visit the AKC web site at:

4. Mail the completed form and check made payable to "CSKC" to the field trial secretary by 12 PM Mountain Time on the closing date April 22, 2014.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances applicable entry fees will be refunded.

## GENERAL INFORMATION PLEASE READ CAREFULLY ALL HANDLERS MUST BE PRESENT FOR ROLL CALL, INSPECTION AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

***Any dog not present 5 minutes after roll call will be considered absent.  
All dogs will be inspected prior to roll call***

### Rules:

1. All dogs entered must be one year of age or older on the day of the test or trial.
2. Veterans are 7 years and older.
3. Dogs not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a five (5) minute grace period.
  1. Each entry will be examined at inspection. Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fee for dogs excused, during inspection, for bitches in season or lameness shall be refunded at a date after the test.
  2. All dogs running on the 600-yard course will run first followed by dogs running on 400 yards(vet) then 300 then 200(vet). Course size is determined by size of dog 400 yds. for veteran dogs 7 & up.
  3. The field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
  4. The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
  5. There will be a \$10 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress, or for anybody caught not picking up after their dog or leaving garbage on the field.
  6. NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the field chairman, except the appointed field committee.
  7. Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.
  8. Control of dogs strictly enforced, on leash at all times NO FLEXI LEASHES except when running.
  9. Clean up and carry out all trash.
  10. Please pick up all dog feces and remove with trash or put in receptacle.

### FIELD AND EQUIPMENT INFORMATION

Terrain is mowed field grass with uneven ground. There is possibility of cactus. Elevation of the course site is about 6800 feet and both days' course layouts include up and downhill slopes. The perimeter of the Zoiboyz ranch is fully fenced.

CSKC will use a battery-powered, continuous loop machine. The lure will consist of white plastic bags.

A \$35.00 fee will be assessed for any returned checks; Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC/CSKC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.

INFORMATION: Port-a-potties on site. BRING WATER AND SHADE FOR YOUR DOGS.

## **FOR FIRST TIME COURSERS AND HANDLERS**

**WHAT ARE PRE-ENTRIES?** - Entries made before the closing date. If your entry is mailed in time yet due to the failure of the postal service it is not received in time for the Test Secretary to have it at the Event, then you will have to fill out day of entry forms on the day of the trial. Always have your dog's registration materials with you when you go to a test.

**WHAT ARE "DAY OF" ENTRIES?** - Entries accepted after the closing date for pre-entries are considered Day of Entries. The deadline for Pre-entries is typically two days before the event. "Day of" entries are usually more expensive because the Field Test Secretary (FTS) must take extra time to add those entries to the record sheets the morning of the test, which delays the start of the trial. If you are entering on the day of the test, you MUST have your completed entry to the Test Secretary BEFORE Roll Call.

**SLIP LEADS** - There is a type of collar for coursing called a slip lead, which is worn only to control the dog prior to release. The collar drops away as the dog is released to chase the lure and they run without anything around their necks that could be dangerous. *SLIP LEADS WILL BE AVAILABE*

**INSPECTION** - Dogs will be inspected by a designated Inspection Committee consisting of at least two persons who are members of the Field Committee and who shall inspect each entered dog for lameness, fitness to compete and female estrus (in season). Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the Inspection Committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete or in season shall not be allowed to enter and the applicable entry fees shall be refunded.

**ROLL CALL** - The time, prior to the commencement of coursing, by which you are supposed to have your dog ready for inspection by the Inspection Committee. At roll call the dog is examined for lameness, *and breed disqualifications (where applicable). Unsprayed bitches are examined to see if they show any evidence of being in season.* After roll call the list of passed hounds is taken to the Field Test Secretary so that the run order can be prepared.

**RUN ORDER LIST** - This is a posted list of the running order for the dogs participating in the event. Always check the record sheet after the Roll Call to confirm your dog's Run Order.

## **FOR EXPERIENCED HANDLERS**

Pre-entered dogs can go directly to the Inspection Committee on the announcement of Roll Call. "Day of" entry dogs can go to Inspection after entries are received. Upon completion of Inspection, the Run Order list will be posted.

### **WHAT MUST MY DOG DO TO PASS THE C.A.T.?**

The Coursing Ability Test (C.A.T.) is a pass/fail test wherein all entrants always run singly. This is to say they run once, and they run alone. Because safety is of the utmost importance, the C.A.T. takes into consideration the individual dog pursuing qualification and therefore has two different course lengths to accommodate the type and size of the entrant. In either case, dogs will chase a lure made of plastic bags.

**CAN MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE FOR COURSING ABILITY?** Three titles will be awarded for dogs that pass the Coursing Ability Test the required number of times. These are suffix titles that will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher-level title superseding a lower level title.

**Coursing Ability (CA)** - Awarded to a dog that passes the Coursing Ability Test three times under at least two different judges.

**Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA)** - Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test ten times.

**Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX)** - Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test 25 times.

**Coursing Ability Excellent 2 (CAX2)** - Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test 50 times. A higher numbered title will be awarded for every additional 25 passes.
